Jeff Walraven gave an update on the Lindsay Municipal Hospital Authority. Performed 15 surgeries, 76 Admits, 13 Procedures, 225 Outpatients, 222 ER Visits, DOC side completely full and Ventilator patients coming to facility, which helps with the budget. In-house portion of audit is completed.

Staff report given by City Manager John Noblitt on the swimming pool and that it probably won't be open this year due to staffing issues, update on the lagoon, Kiowa Street, Storm Water/Drainage Project, 76N project and a special Thank You to the Hospital for providing Name Badges at no cost to the City.




